

## Giving of Communion

Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world

may sit and eat in your kingdom.  
Amen.**

*On receiving the bread and wine each one should reply* **Amen.**

*After Communion the President will say the post-communion prayer.*

**Father of all, God of our pilgrimage  
we give you thanks and praise,  
that when we were still far off  
you met us in your Son and brought us home.  
May we who share Christ's body  
live his risen life;  
we who drink his cup  
bring life to others;  
we whom the Spirit lights  
give light to the world.  
Refresh us and sustain us as we go forward on our journey with you,  
in the name of Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.**

He was led like a lamb to the slaughter.  
He suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
And descended to the dead.**

**We believe in Jesus Christ, now risen

**Taking of the Bread and Wine**

heaven and on earth is yours.

your own do we give you. Amen.**

**The Eucharistic Prayer**

The Lord is here.

Lift up your hearts.  
**We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the  
Lord our God.  
**It is right to give thanks and** praise.

*The president praises God for his mighty  
acts and all respond*

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,

your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.  
Blessed is he who comes in  
the name of the Lord.

*The president recalls the Last Supper,  
and one of these four acclamations may  
be used*

Great is the mystery of faith:

Christ is risen:  
Christ will come again.**

Praise to you, Lord Jesus:  
**Dying you destroyed our death,  
rising you restored our life:  
Lord Jesus, come in glory.**

Christ is the bread of life:  
**When we eat this bread and drink  
this cup,  
we proclaim your death,  
Lord Jesus,  
until you come in glory.**

Jesus Christ is Lord:  
**Lord, by your cross and  
resurrection  
you have set us free.  
You are the Saviour  
of the world.**

*The Prayer continues and leads into the  
doxology, to which all respond boldly*  
**Amen.**

As our Saviour taught us, so we pray

**Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name,  
your kingdom come,  
your will be done,  
on earth as in heaven.  
Give us today our daily  
bread.  
Forgive us our sins

now and for ever. Amen.**
